Mission Statement

Provide effective coaching and development through positive feedback and a structured program based around the key performance indicators. This will equip referees with the tools, knowledge, skills and opportunities they need to become more effective referees and achieve the goals they set for themselves.

1. A coach will uphold the Rugby League National Code of Conduct.
2. A coach will teach referees to officiate fairly and to respect the laws, players and officials.
3. A coach will ensure that all referees get equal instruction and support.
4. A coach will not ridicule or berate referees for making mistakes or performing poorly.
5. A coach will uphold the CRL criteria of not talking to referees at breaks about their game.
6. A coach will not interfere in any way with the official running of matches.
7. A coach will continue to upgrade their coaching skills and accept instruction from the coaching panel.
8. A coach will work in cooperation with other coaches and management for the benefit of the association by giving constructive feedback and participate in the development program.
9. A coach will declare all actual and perceived conflicts of interest relating to their circumstances by the commencement of each season.



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
