MOD RUGBY LEAGUE

If you replace a player for the remainder of the match, or is dismissed

- At the conclusion of the game write down the players name, jersey number and club.
- SMS these details to the secretary straight after you completed your appointments
- Go to www.group6referees.com.au click on dismissal and incident forms
- Fill out the dismissal form with all details that are required.
- Any issues please contact the Secretary.
- All dismissal reports must be received to the Secretary by 9pm Sunday.

DISMISSALS - JUNIOR INTERNATIONAL U13- U16

- At the conclusion of the game write down the players name, jersey number and club
- SMS with above details must be sent to the secretary straight after your completed your appointments
- Go to www.group6referees.com.au click on dismissal and incident forms
- Fill out the dismissal form with all details that are required.
- Any issues please contact the Secretary.
- All dismissal reports must be received to the Secretary by 9pm Sunday.



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DISMISSALS - SENIORS

- At the conclusion of the game write down the players name, jersey number and club
- SMS with above details must be sent to the secretary straight after your completed your appointments
- Go to www.group6referees.com.au click on dismissal and incident forms
- Fill out the dismissal form with all details that are required.
- Any issues please contact the Secretary.
- All dismissal reports must be received to the Secretary by 9pm Sunday.

ON REPORT - SENIORS

- A player may be placed on report in ANY senior game that is officially video recorded.
- When you place a player on report. Signal on report by creating a cross with your arms across your face indicating to the table and the video recorder that the player is on report. Face the camera when placing the player on report. This must be done before you restart play and or immediately after the incident.
- ON REPORT IS NOT A SUBSTITUTE FOR DISMISSAL.
- Record the players name, jersey number and club
- YOU MUST RECORD THE TIME IN THE GAME WHEN THE PLAYER WAS PLACED ON REPORT. THIS ASSISTS IN REVIEWING THE VIDEO FOR THE INCIDENT
- SMS must be sent to the secretary straight after you completed your appointments
- Go to www.group6referees.com.au click on dismissal and incident forms



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- Fill out the dismissal form with all details that are required. Record time of incident in the narrative section.
- Any issues please contact the Secretary.
- All reports must be received to the Secretary by 9pm Sunday.

NOTE: EMAILING OF PLAYERS ON REPORT IS NO LONGER ACCEPTED. IT MUST BE ON A DISMISSAL REPORT NOT AN INCIDENT REPORT FORM.
